## **Supplies**

<u>Preschool</u>- 1 container Clorox wipes, 2 plastic folders, 1 <u>small</u> blanket, 1 <u>small</u> pillow, 1 family picture, Pencil pouch, 1 box Kleenex

<u>Kindergarten</u>: 2 folders, 1 box of Kleenex, 1 pair of children's headphones (labeled with child's name), 1 box Crayola Markers, **Girls Only:** 1 Box Gallon Zip Lock Bags, **Boys Only**: 1 Roll Paper Towels

<u>First Grade</u>: 2 folders with pockets, 2 family size boxes of Kleenex, 1 pair of headphones (any brand), Two 1" Binders. **Girls Only**: 1 container of Lysol or Clorox wipes (not baby wipes) and 1 box quart Ziploc bags with plastic slider for sealing. **Boys Only**: 1 (8 oz. or larger) bottle hand sanitizer containing greater than 60% alcohol and 1 box gallon Ziploc bags with plastic slider for sealing

<u>Second Grade</u>: 2 folders with pockets, Two 1" hard cover 3-ring View binders, 1 pair durable children's headphones (not earbuds, any brand), 2 yellow highlighters, 1 plastic clip board 9" x 13" (or similar size), 1 (8 oz. or larger) bottle hand sanitizer with pump, 1 roll paper towles

<u>Third Grade</u>: 1 pocket folder, One 1" three ring binder, 1 large box of Kleenex, 1 pair of durable headphones (not earbuds, any brand). **GIRLS ONLY**: 1 box snack size ziplock bags. **BOYS ONLY**: 1 box quart size Ziploc bags

<u>Fourth Grade</u>: 12 or more #2 lead pencils (<u>not mechanical</u>), 2 boxes of Kleenex, 1 pair of durable headphones (not earbuds, any brand), 1 skein of yarn the color of your child's choice (need by December), 1 container of Lysol or Clorox wipes
