The Southeast Dubois County School Corporation does not qualify to participate in the USDA funded Summer Feeding Program. To be eligible a school must meet one of the of following criteria to participate in the program:

- The attendance area of a school in which at least 50 percent of the enrolled children have been determined eligible for free or reduced-price school meals under the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program.
- A geographic area where, based on the most recent census data available or information provided from a department of welfare or zoning commission, at least 50 percent of the children residing in that area are eligible for free or reduced-price school meals under the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program.
- A geographic area where a site demonstrates, based on other approved sources, that at least 50 percent of the children enrolled at the site are eligible for free or reduced-price meals under the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program.

## Locations & Resources for Summer Meals

USDA meal programs for children operate all summer! To find the nearest summer meal site, **call 211 or text 'Summer Meals' (English) or 'Verano' (Spanish) to 914-342-7744**. Households in need of assistance any time of the year can call the USDA National Hunger Hotline at 866-3-HUNGRY to speak with a representative who will find resources, such as summer meal sites, food banks, and other nearby social services.

Free meals are available to all children in Dubois County 18 and younger and to persons over 18 years old who are enrolled in a state-approved education program for the mentally or physically disabled. The meals are provided to all children and are the same for all participants.
