The Forest Park Band Boosters held their monthly meeting on Tuesday, July 5, 2016 in the high school band room.

Lisa Dale, President, welcomed boosters.

Minutes from the June meeting were approved by motion of Theresa Luebbehusen and seconded by Kurt Boeglin.

Susan Blume gave the treasurer's report and the 2016-17 Operating Budget was also presented. The budget was approved by the boosters.

The next aluminum can and paper drive will be held July 16 at 9 am.

Susan Blume gave the report on the Heimatfest food booth. Not all receipts are final. The new cash handling process was implemented starting with this event and will continue for all future booths.

The mandatory parent meeting for all current high school and incoming Junior High band students will be July 14 at 7 pm. Letters were sent to parents. Information will be given about the Flea Market, mattress sales and student incentives, student accounts and fall raffle tickets. Raffle tickets will be distributed at the end of band camp week.

Rodney Welp reported that Flea Market sorting is done. Some boxing and pricing of items remains. Loading of items will take place from 5-8 pm on August 1-2 at the Woodmaster warehouse in St. Marks. Much help will be needed and workers are asked to bring 2-wheelers (dollies) to help move items. On Wednesday, August 3, unloading of furniture and cabinets begins at 7 am at the fairgrounds. Any help is appreciated and needed. Thursday will be a set-up and organization day in the buildings. The Flea Market begins Friday, August 5 at 5 am and continues Saturday, August 6 at 6 am. Sign-ups will begin soon via Sign-up Genius for workers.

Football concessions will begin August 12. Rodney Welp and Lisa Dale are in the process of making the schedule for workers.

The 4-H Food Booth worker schedule is nearly complete. Student sign-ups will be available at mini-camp. The booth will be open from 4-10:30 pm Tuesday through Friday and Saturday from 7 am-8 pm.

The band will again have a food booth at the Ferdinand Folk Festival on September 17. More details will follow.

Kurt Boeglin reported that a faucet was replaced in the 4-H food booth. He will also seek a quote on the cost of painting the box truck.

Rodney Blume reported that the roof on the band prop/recycling building is in need of repair. Repair information and cost will be obtained.

The props for the show are progressing and work continues on the tarps. Work has begun on the flags. The committee is asking that anyone with woodburning tools contact them. The tools would be used

for cutting some of the flag fabric. Carl Jones gave a report on cutting the jewel shapes for use on the band uniforms.

Uniform fitting will begin Monday, July 11 after mini-camp. Students will be notified when they are to be fitted.

Teresa Gress reported that quotes are being obtained for marching season meals. For the sign committee, she requested some new wood for the signs that are painted and posted during marching season.

Mr. Gayso reported that percussion has completed their first month of practice. Mini-camp is July 11-14 and students will need to bring their own dinner. Band camp will be held July 25-29 from 10 am-8 pm with Friday 10 am to approximately 6 pm. A public performance will follow on Friday evening. Dinner will be provided for students at band camp.

The meeting was adjourned by Rodney Welp and seconded by Rodney Mason.

In place of the August meeting, loading for the Flea Market will take place at the Woodmaster warehouse in St. Marks from 5-8 pm.

The September meeting will be held Tuesday, September 6 at 7:30 due to the holiday on Monday.
