The Forest Park Band Boosters held their monthly meeting on Monday, July 9, 2018 in the band room.

Lori Mason, President, welcomed boosters.

Minutes from the June meeting were approved by Rob Randle and seconded by Alan Winkler.

Rodney Welp gave a brief financial report. The proposed budget for 2018-2019 was presented by the board. After a brief discussion and explanation, the budget was approved by those in attendance.

Alan Winkler gave a brief report on the new parent picnic held on July 8.

The next aluminum can and paper drive will be held on Saturday, July 14 at 9 am. The team is looking for two new team leaders. Any help on the second Saturday of the month is appreciated and the team welcomes new members.

Rodney Welp gave an update on the Flea Market. Sorting is mostly complete and help is needed for cleaning and tagging items. Shelly Buechler and Jan Wallhauser also gave an update from the food committee as they prepare for band camp week and marching season.
