The Forest Park Band Boosters held their monthly meeting on Monday, June 5, 2017 in the high school band room.

Susan Blume gave the treasurer's report and stated that the budget for 2017-2018 will be presented and voted on at the July meeting.

Kathy Wilmes gave a report on the food booth for the 4-H Fair. The tentative schedule will be for the booth to be open most of the day Sunday, July 16, all day Wednesday, July 19 and 4-10:30 pm on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday of fair week. Committee members will be notified for shift sign-ups.

The maintenance and equipment committee stated that repairs will be needed on the exhaust system of the box truck.
