****It is always a good idea to keep the registration form or "payment receipt" issued by the college or university for future reference of the course documentation.**

In order to make the best decision possible on which dual credit courses will be most beneficial during their college career, each student is responsible to do background research of the requirements of the school they are planning to attend for the major they are pursuing.

Only the receiving college or university can evaluate and determine the final transferability of any course credit. Forest Park cannot guarantee the transfer of any dual credits.

There is no longer a state-imposed limit on dual credits; however, individual high schools or institutions of higher education may establish their own policy. In the recent past, Indiana's policy limited dual credits from one institution to 15 credits. This policy was changed in February, 2010.

Once a dual credit course is completed, the high school instructor reports the final grade back to the college/university which offered the course.

Students must note that dual credits can only be transferred to another college or university when they contact the Office of the Registrar from where the dual credits were originally attained.
